



DAY 1: Arrival in Colombo & Transfer to Negombo

Distance / Travel Time: 10 km / 30 min

Accommodation: Amagi Aria Hotel or Similar

Meal Plan: Dinner

Highlights:

- Arrival at Bandaranaike International Airport
- Visit Negombo Fish Market
- Relax at coastal hotel

Arrive at Bandaranaike International Airport and meet your tour representative for a warm Sri Lankan welcome. After a short reception, transfer to Negombo, a charming coastal town known for its colonial architecture and scenic lagoons. Take a stroll through the bustling Negombo Fish Market to witness the vibrant local life and enjoy the sights and sounds of this picturesque town. Check in to your hotel and unwind, soaking in the tranquil seaside atmosphere before your exciting journey begins.

DAY 2: Negombo – Dambulla – Golden Cave Temples

Distance / Travel Time: 150 km / 4–5 hrs

Accommodation: Tropical Life Resort or Similar

Meal Plan: Breakfast, Dinner

Highlights:

- Explore Dambulla Cave Temple
- Marvel at the Golden Buddha
- Evening relaxation at hotel

After a leisurely breakfast, depart for Dambulla, home to one of Sri Lanka's most famous cultural treasures. Visit the remarkable Dambulla Cave Temple, adorned with ancient murals and Buddha statues that narrate the island's rich spiritual history. DAY 3: Sigiriya - Cultural Village & Rock Fortress

Distance / Travel Time: 21 km / 45 min

Accommodation: Tropical Life Resort or Similar

Meal Plan: Breakfast, Dinner

- Cultural village experience with bullock cart ride
- Climb Sigiriya Rock Fortress
- Sunset trek at Pidurangala Rock

Start your day with a visit to a local cultural village, where you can explore traditional Sri Lankan village life, take a bullock cart ride, cross a scenic lake, and try your hand at cooking authentic local dishes. Later, climb the iconic Sigiriya Rock Fortress, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, to admire ancient palace ruins and panoramic views of the surrounding countryside. End the day with a sunset trek to Pidurangala Rock and enjoy the breathtaking scenery before returning to your hotel.

DAY 4: Dambulla – Matale – Kandy – Spice Gardens & Sacred Temple

Distance / Travel Time: 75 km / 2 hrs

Accommodation: Cinnamon Citadel Hotel or Similar

Meal Plan: Breakfast, Dinner

Highlights:

- Visit a spice garden in Matale
- Explore the Temple of the Sacred Tooth Relic
- Evening cultural dance show

Travel to Kandy via Matale, stopping at a spice garden to learn about the cultivation and uses of Sri Lanka's famous spices. Upon reaching Kandy, visit the revered Temple of the Sacred Tooth Relic, one of the island's most sacred Buddhist shrines. In the evening, immerse yourself in traditional Sri Lankan culture with a vibrant dance show showcasing music, folklore, and dance. Check in to your hotel and enjoy a peaceful evening.



DAY 5: Kandy – Pinnawala Elephant Sanctuary & Botanical Gardens

Distance / Travel Time: 35 km / 1 hr (approx.)

Accommodation: Cinnamon Citadel Hotel or Similar

Meal Plan: Breakfast, Dinner

Highlights:

- Visit Pinnawala Elephant Sanctuary
- Interact with elephants and enjoy local lunch
- Explore Peradeniya Royal Botanical Gardens

Spend the morning at Pinnawala Elephant Sanctuary, where you can walk with elephants, watch them bathe, and enjoy a local lunch while learning about their care and social behavior. In the afternoon, visit the beautiful Peradeniya Royal Botanical Gardens, home to exotic orchids and endemic plant species. Explore Kandy city highlights, including Kandy Lake and local artisan shops, before returning to your hotel for an evening of relaxation.

DAY 6: Kandy – Nuwara Eliya – Scenic Train to Ella

Distance / Travel Time: 155 km / 5 hrs (by road, then train)

Accommodation: Ella Flower Garden Hotel or Similar

Meal Plan: Breakfast, Dinner

Highlights:

- Visit tea estate and factory in Nuwara Eliya
- Scenic train journey from Nanu Oya to Ella
- Breathtaking hill country views

Drive through picturesque tea plantations to Nuwara Eliya and visit a tea estate to experience the Ceylon tea production process. Board the famous train from Nanu Oya to Ella, enjoying sweeping views of misty valleys, tea fields, and cliffs along the way. Upon arrival, meet your driver and transfer to the hotel, taking in the serene hill country atmosphere.



DAY 7: Ella – Little Adam's Peak & Nine Arch Bridge

Distance / Travel Time: Short local travel

Accommodation: Ella Flower Garden Hotel or Similar

Meal Plan: Breakfast, Dinner

Highlights:

- Hike Little Adam's Peak
- Visit Nine Arch Bridge
- Explore Ella town

After breakfast, hike the scenic Little Adam's Peak to enjoy stunning views of the surrounding hills and valleys. Later, visit the iconic Nine Arch Bridge, a marvel of colonial-era engineering amidst lush greenery. Spend the afternoon exploring the charming town of Ella at your own pace, or relax at a café enjoying the cool mountain air.

DAY 8: Ella – Udawalawa – Elephant Transit Home

Distance / Travel Time: 100 km / 2 hrs

Accommodation: Grand Udawalawa Safari Hotel or Similar

Meal Plan: Breakfast, Dinner

Highlights:

- Visit Elephant Transit Home
- Scenic waterfalls along the route
- Relax at hotel surrounded by nature

Drive to Udawalawa through beautiful countryside, stopping at scenic waterfalls en route. Visit the Elephant Transit Home to witness baby elephants being cared for and prepared for release into the wild. Check in to your hotel and relax, enjoying the peace and natural beauty of this tranquil region.

DAY 9: Udawalawa – Galle – Safari & Historic Fort

Distance / Travel Time: 130 km / 2.5 hrs

Accommodation: Garton's Cape Hotel or Similar

Meal Plan: Breakfast, Dinner

Highlights:

- Jeep safari in Udawalawa National Park
- Cooking class and local lunch in Galle
- Explore UNESCO-listed Galle Fort

Begin the day with a jeep safari in Udawalawa National Park to spot elephants, monkeys, and other wildlife. Proceed to Galle and participate in a local cooking class with a traditional Sri Lankan lunch. In the evening, explore Galle Fort, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and enjoy a tuk-tuk ride through the city, capturing the sunset from the fort walls.

DAY 10: Galle – Airport – Farewell Sri Lanka

Distance / Travel Time: 160 km / 2.5 hrs
